Objectives

a) Research programme and participation in international committee work

- Encouragement of research on the structures and dynamics, the problems and policies of individual megacities, and support of theoretical approaches under a comparative view, with special emphasis on megacities of the developing countries.
- Leading role of the task force in the development, promulgation and dissemination of new research topics on megacities. Broadening of the international discussion.
- · Definition and critical assessment of the central problems of megacities: research foci, tasks, and deficits.
- Concentration on selected topics of major research foci. Scientific agenda to be defined and finalised within the task force group.
- · Special publications.
- Promotion of modern methods in megacity research (Remote Sensing, Geographical Information Systems, modern qualitative methods of social sciences) in collaboration with relevant organisations.
- Presence at and participation in major international conferences.
- Own IGU-task force booth, itinerant exhibition, poster presence.

b) Information und services

- Homepage for (i) general and public information and (ii) communication within the task force.
- Information service and centre for research on megacities (e.g. statistics, map information, pictures, aerial photographs, satellite images, data, publications, bibliography, WWW-links, press contacts and news).
- · Communication platform for task force members and corresponding members.
- · In the long run: "Best practice" databank on problem solving perspectives in megacity management.

c) Networks and networking

- Support activities leading to a deepened exchange of information regarding megacity research, among geographers and throughout the IGU as well as interdisciplinary.
- Networking with relevant organisations and initiatives.
- Provide assistance with research applications within the community of scientists.
